## WEEK 1: DIVORCE, SPOUSAL MAINTENANCE & SETTLEMENT

**Divorce**—What is it, Who can apply for it and how to apply.

**Spousal Maintenance**—Who is entitled to spousal maintenance, what entitlements can be expected and the process in reaching a spousal maintenance arrangement.

**Property Settlement**—Options available to parties for reaching such an arrangement, namely informal arrangements, binding and consent orders.

## WEEK 2: PARENTING

This seminar is aimed at parents that have separated and need to make arrangements for children under the age of 18yrs. This seminar explains parenting plans and consent orders, and the advantages and disadvantages of each. The seminar will also cover:

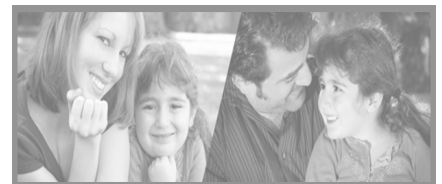
- Court Processes
- Factors that the Courts will consider.
- Orders that a court is likely to make.



## WEEK 3: CHILD SUPPORT ASSESSMENT

Child support payments are those made by one parent to the other to help with the caring costs of the child. This seminar sets out who is eligible for child support and how the child support can be arranged including:

- Informal arrangements
- Formal agreements (binding and limited child support agreements)
- Child support assessment through Child Support Agency; and
- Court Orders



## WEEK 4: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

This seminar considers what constitutes domestic violence and the options available to parties confronted by domestic violence, including protection orders under state and federal legislation. We will discuss how to apply for a protection order and the legal protection that will be ordered.
